The project entitled “The role of glioma-derived signaling molecules in macrophage polarization and shaping anti-tumor immune responses” aims to discover mechanisms responsible for deregulated expression, secretion and postranslational modifications of signaling molecules in tumors and their effects on immune microenvironment of glioblastomas.
