When you enter the Institute from the park can admire photographs of Nencki scientists at field experiments. The apparatus placed in the showcases has been in use until quite recently for histology and biochemistry research as well as physiology and hydrobiology experiments. The gem of the exhibit is a de Fonbrune microforge, which was used to prepare tools for the micromanipulation.
