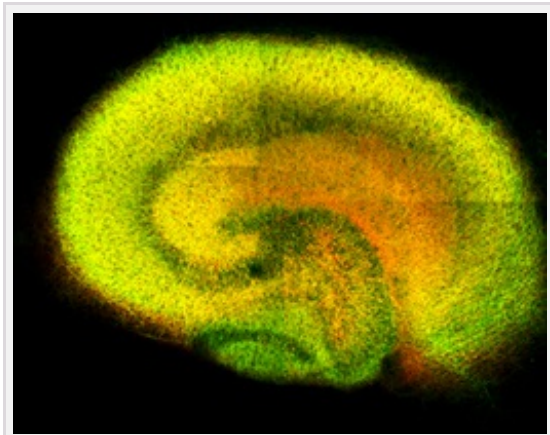

We are pleased to announce that project “NEBI – National Imaging Centre for biological and biomedical sciences” coordinated by the Nencki Institute of Experimental Biology is among five projects on the Road Map in the category: “Efficient healthcare and increasing the effectiveness of health promoting activities”. NEuro-BioImaging Poland is a platform for integrating the Polish biomedical imaging community, developing and applying imaging techniques as one of their core research methods.
